

JACKETS REQUIRED

Assignment Produce at least three sets of tight pencil thumbnails for your book jacket layout. Include the front/back panels, spine and both the front and back inside flaps - all in proportion to your book size. Make this approximately 1/4 to 1/2 the scale of your original book. These will be reviewed in class on the following week. Once approved to proceed further, a tighter, more comprehensive layout will be required before the final art is produced.

Please continue working on your book document in InDesign. Set up all your various style sheets for paragraph and heading styles, along with indents, initial caps and any other styles deemed necessary for your book and flow your text on the pages. Illustrations for books should be soon completed if not at this time. Refrain from any extensive text tweaking of texts to accommodate orphans and widows until all of it is input and styles are adjusted to your liking. This may otherwise lead to some very uneven letter and word spacing, and it should only be done near your final edit.
